

Types of Cards

Here is the description of the different types of cards that are used in having the conversation. These are for determining the order of play and additional options during play.

	This will be either a Directions or Survey card. Both have a scan code. Scan and follow the instructions. How many are in a deck - 2
 Whose Turn Is It	These cards are used to determine the order of who will pick a card. Used with the Numbers cards. How many are in a deck - 6
 Numbers	Numbers 1 – 6. Used with the Whose Turn Is It cards. How many are in a deck - 6
 OPTIONS	Swap (3) - Use this to swap a question for another. Skip (3) - Use this card to skip answering a question. 2 for 1 (3) - Use this card to ask two questions instead of one. Blank (15) - These were made to build the odds, so not everyone pulls a swap, skip or, 2 for 1 card. It also allows for additional cards to be added in future editions. How many are in a deck – The number is in () after the type of card.
