

How Many Can Play

Although this was initially designed for two people learning about each other, it can also be used in a group to learn more about others. The cards to determine the order of play goes up to six. If there are more that want to answer questions, as a group you can determine the order of play.

Participants: 1 -6 people

1 Participant

1. Pick a card and answer the question as it applies to you. Get to know yourself.
2. Use the cards to ask someone else questions, when you want to get to know them and you're not sure where you may want it to go.

2 Participants

1. **One deck:** When you are in person - Each person should take turns pulling cards to ask or answer questions.
2. **Two decks: When you are not in the same room asking questions** - Each person should take turns pulling cards to ask or answer questions. You can video each other or talk over the phone.

2 – 6 Participants

1. **One deck:** When you are in person - Each person should take turns pulling cards to ask or answer questions.
2. **Two - Six decks:** When you a part - Each person should take turns pulling cards to ask or answer questions.
